FROM THE APOSTLE'S DESK

RESPONDING TO WORLDLY DEMANDS IN A BIBLICAL WAY

I received an interesting joke and yet with a deep lesson via sms during the month of July 2009. The joke went something like this: *I visited the police station the other day and next to the door seated on a chair, I spotted a policeman reading a Bible. Out of curiosity, I decided to 'test' his Bible knowledge and asked him whether he knew who Abel's killer was. He answered that he was not the one dealing with murder cases at the station, but he can take me to his colleague tasked with that responsibility.* My immediate thought about this was that many times we pose as Christians and yet in actual fact we do not have a real relationship with Jesus Christ.

Contrary to the secular world's cynical endeavors to demean and rubbish the Bible as nothing more than a historical chronicle and fable, it stands tall as the Word of God containing a kaleidoscope of mysteries, secrets, formulas and divine revelation. The most painful sight for me is the plight of God's people on the continent of Africa through natural disasters which are sometimes demonically orchestrated owing to occultic doorways as a result of witchcraft practices, through man-made wars and high leveled political corruption in some instances. Dambisa Moyo in her book, "Dead Aid-Why Aid Is Not Working And How There Is Another Way For Africa" notes that: *"More than US \$2 trillion of foreign aid has been transferred from rich countries to poor over the past fifty years- Africa the biggest recipient, by far. Yet regardless of the motivation for aid-giving-economic, political or moral - aid has failed to deliver the promise of sustainable economic growth and poverty reduction"*.

We must realize that even though aid remains at the heart of the development agenda, it has not lived up to expectations. This is despite the fact that there are compelling reasons to show that it perpetuates the cycle of poverty and derails sustainable economic growth. **Isaiah 30:1** "Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help, And rely on horses, Who trust in chariots because they are very strong, But who do not look to the Holy One of Israel, Nor seek the Lord!" This scripture, like thousands others in the Word of God is unequivocal in its declaration that the answer lies with God through His Word! The Word of God contains divine strategies for all aspects of Man's life, viz. marriage, health, family, children, friends, enemies, finance and much, much more! The Bible is the road map, the menu to an abundant life of dominion both here on the earth and in eternity! It is eternal in its message because it is the Word of God.

I received an email which actually pleased my heart because the issue of poverty alleviation and sustainable economic development are priority interests to me both as a minister of the gospel and a community activist. The e-mail came from an organization called ANSA-Alternatives to Neo-Liberalism in Southern Africa.

The first paragraph explained that the ANSA Project "is an attempt to outline the changes needed in Southern Africa to liberate the region from the shackles of neo-liberalism. It hopes to provide a basis for discussions amongst workers, farmers, women, intellectuals, youth, NGOs and politicians that are willing to find solutions to mass poverty, exclusion and exploitation".

What encouraged me about the mail was that it was an invitation to attend a workshop at a local Windhoek hotel where the matter at hand would be explained and expounded upon so that we are able to spread the thinking through empowering other people with the knowledge we would receive. Unfortunately I was unable to attend, but I did indicate to the sender of the invitation that I am willing to be fully involved in any intervention that aims at poverty alleviation in our country and continent. The condition being that there must not be any hidden political agenda or any sort of sectarian tendencies based on the bias of those who either fund or implement the ideas of the organization. The fact that they invited some of us as church leaders was a huge encouragement to me because it gives an indication that those who are seriously seeking solutions to the perplexing problems our societies face recognize the capacity of the church to assist.

Now when we as the Body of Christ respond to such clarion calls and needs, we have to ensure that we do it from a clearly biblical point of view. **Psalm 127:1 "Unless the Lord builds the house, They labor in vain who build it..."**

It is clear from the Word of God that the formula to build anything of substance and sustainability, God must be involved. The world we live in is organized according to institutionalized systems which when implemented are meant to serve the 2% of the world's population that owns 50% of the earth's wealth. All man-made institutions while exposing the amazing ability of man to organize himself, are prone to manipulations through technology and intellectualism for personal, selfish gain for those who carry out such exercises. The complexity and the speed of technological advancement (not necessarily for our enhancement) of the world is enough to stress, confuse and depress anyone who does not meander the maze that the matrix of life creates to the point of committing suicide. This is more so where there is a deficit in the relationship with Jesus Christ through the Bible.

Space really does not allow me to elaborate on many concepts I have mentioned, however, please note that I am readily available to discuss and debate this subject with anyone who desires to interrogate and explore it further!
