REFLECTIONS ON MILESTONES OF NO WALLS APOSTOLIC HOUSE OF GOD

God bless you all as you read this article and together with us glorify God who stands behind His Word. As we live life in seasons, I want to say that there is a season to project vision and a season to reflect position. In this article I want to summarize my reflections as I list the milestones of NO WALLS APOSTOLIC HOUSE OF GOD since it's inception seven years ago. I received the name of the ministry from the Lord Himself and my dad who went to be with the Lord five years ago had told my husband that the ministry he will lead will be a 'church with no walls'. I also received **Jeremiah 1:9-10** which are the foundational scriptures of the ministry from the Lord. NO WALLS APOSTOLIC HOUSE OF GOD started at our home around the swimming pool. When my husband who was a respected diplomat at the time came to Christ, many people expected us to join an existing 'church', but that was not what God was telling him. He went to South Africa and resigned his job and from that day our lives were changed because we stepped into a life of faith in God. The desire to leave ministry always lingered because it was never easy to live a life of total dependency on God. Although we have been in business, even our business wells dried up at one stage and the persecution from the religious folk just seemed to be on the increase and even more aggressive. However, by the grace of God all we did was concentrate on the vision God gave us and we also exercised the scripture that taught us to pray for our enemies if one may call them that. One of the things we learnt was that ministry is also God's way of shaping and reconstituting the character and spiritual DNA of the visionary. The ministry started as deliverance and prayer ministry that made us travel around the country as the Lord had given us the grace to revive ministries. The people began to throng our home in Khomasdal to the point that we had to find another venue to pray for people as the entire affair was becoming more and more serious and a disturbance to our neighbors. We saw many miracles, signs and wonders as though God wanted to ensure that we will be encouraged to keep doing what He had purposed for us. We were then allowed to minister from the ground floor of the Khomasdal Baptist church building. The teaching, praying, preaching and ministrations grew so big that the Baptists in front of whom I had grown up as that ministry had started in my parents' home twenty years prior, agreed that we minister officially out of the entire building. Those were wonderful days because we saw all tribes and ethnic groups of Namibia, Black, White and Brown gathering in the building and praising the Lord together in unity. To us this was it! This was revival breaking out in the nation from Khomasdal. However, in the middle of the euphoria, the Lord whispered to my husband that after two years we must be ready to move on. Two years to the day, on a windy Saturday morning, a pastor from a wonderful ministry in Katutura came to speak to us to assist him because the ministry was coming under heavy witchcraft attack. The spirit of God immediately arrested my husband's spirit to tell him to respond positively and to sow a specific financial seed into the ministry. The seed was exactly what the ministry needed to renovate its building. Our time at that particular ministry was blessed because of the love we enjoyed from the children of God. I believe that the Praise and Worship was always a highlight. From our days at the Baptist church, we loved having periodic Praise and Worship evenings that would fill the place to overflowing. The period of time that the Lord gave us to be with our other friends in the church in Katutura was six months. However we were forced to leave after four months and that cost a man's life. It really was a good place to be, but ended badly owing to disobedience, not on our part, but on the part of our host. In all this time I watched as God through the Holy Spirit was reprogramming my husband and changing his character. We spent lots of time in fasting and prayer as well as taking communion as often as we could. What helped us was that we remained focused on Christ and we believed what God told us. We then spent a short while in our friends' ministry which was also based in Katutura and from there we worked for a while with yet another ministry in Katutura. *Continued on page 4*

Another interesting move from God in our lives in ministry was when the Lord sent us to assist a pre-dominantly Afrikaner church. When my husband asked God why he was now where he was, the Lord responded into his spirit by telling him that wealth is not in the townships, but in the suburbs among the very people where he was. The instruction from the Lord was that he should marry the mantle of wealth. So he did.

During 2005, the Lord took us into a place of obscurity and opened doors for us to minister to commercial farmers. Oh! Children of God, it was such a lovely year, such closeness to God. We then, through one of the sisters in the ministry and the favor of God got a classroom at the Gammams Training Centre in which to worship. The place would also fill up and the signs and wonders continued. We also started a Deliverance Centre in Walvis Bay and in the same year we began to broadcast on TBN Namibia through the good hearts of the owners of TBN Namibia with whom God gave us favor. Whilst operating from Gammams Training Centre we were invited by another pastor to minister for him on a Sunday. It was here that we met Pastor Mara Booyesen and her husband Ryno with whom we shared the wider vision given to us by God. They then shared with us how the spirit of God had impressed upon them to build a chapel for the gospel to the memory of Mara's mother. It was here that the Valley of Angels was born on plot No3 Brakwater which my husband had see three years prior. There is much more that I would have loved to include in this article but then I guess that will have to be in the book to be published sometime in the near future. Today we lead an Apostolic House with six churches and many others under our covering in Namibia, twenty seven churches across Angola and eleven churches receiving apostolic covering from us in Mozambique with one in Perth, Australia. We also serve as a member on the Council of African Apostles and this year saw the start of our Bible College at the Valley of Angels. All the glory belongs to our God whose grace has been truly sufficient for us as a family and a ministry.
